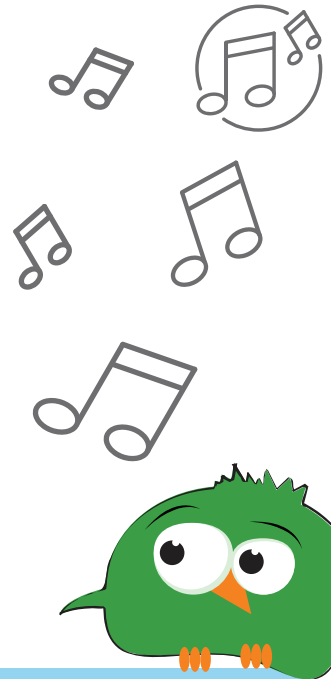
Shake and Shake

Make your own dinosaur feet!

Create your own dinosaur feet and have fun wearing them as you stomp and roar just like the dinosaurs on the bus!

- Take two sheets of A4 paper.
- Draw a dinosaur shaped foot on one sheet and then cut these out together so you have two identical shapes.
- Decorate these in any way you like – you could add triangular shaped claws, patterns or scales.

- Cut a cross toward the back of the foot, in the middle. This is where your little one will put their foot through so the dinosaur foot will sit around each ankle.
- Help your child to poke their feet through each hole and get ready to stomp!
